Lady Bird Berry Bugs

Everyone knows you should not eat Lady Bird Bugs. They they protect the flowers from aphids, and apparently can be a tad bitter. Caterina always tempted by a big juicy bug, makes these alternatives for her guests.

Each chef will need:

Strawberries large blueberries, or small purple grapes (use what's in season) mini chocolate chips

You may also need: toothpicks, or lettuce for display

- 1. Wash strawberries very well. Cut off the green tops and halve lengthwise to give a flat surface for the bug to sit on.
- 2. Push several mini chocolate chips, point in, into each side of the top of the berry to make spots.
- 3. Either attach blue berry/grape head to the bug body using a toothpick, or, if small birds will be attending the party, place the head next the body on a display tray which can be lined with a lettuce leaf for color. (Caterina doesn't like baby birds to get stuck by sharp toothpics)
